Program Description:

Focuses on musical performance and the organisation and production of live musical events. Offers a practical approach to learning about musical theory, technical and production skills, musical analysis and the use of technology to develop an artistic performance and market music as a product.

Certificate IV in Live Production, Theatre and Events (Technical Operations)

Program Description:

This qualification focuses on the roles of those working in stage production and lighting production and allows participants to perform a range of skilled duties including set construction, sound and lighting installation, theatrical design and stage management.

Diploma of Music Industry (Technical Production)

Program Description:

Covers all aspects of live sound reinforcement, theatrical lighting and music production, including PA systems, recording, editing and mixing, MDI programming, music theory, composition and industry studies. Acquire the knowledge and skills required to begin a career in the music, arts or entertainment industry. Software used includes Pro Tools and Reason amongst others.

Duration: 1 year full time

Career Outcomes: Sound Engineer, Studio Engineer, Radio/Television and Audio Technician, Theatre Audio and Lighting Technician, Road Crew Assistant.



Certificate IV in Applied Fashion Design and Technology

This program will teach students basic sewing skills which will then develop into the production of whole garments.

Share Investment Short Course

Program Description:

Mandatory for people wishing to purchase Management Rights. Learn how to manage agency risk, property management services, maintain trust accounts, property management activities and transactions and lease property.

Duration: 3 weeks part time or up to 26 weeks flexible delivery
Offering: Semester 1 and 2 (three offerings per semester)
Campus: Southport

Career Outcomes: Apply for registration to own or manage residential and holiday letting apartments through the Queensland Office of Fair Trading.

Certificate IV in Property Services (Operations)

Program Description:

Obtain skills and knowledge about managing body corporate meetings, contract development, strata management meetings, reporting on financial activity and coordination of maintenance and repairs.

Duration: Up to 26 weeks flexible delivery
Offering: Semester 1 and 2
